About the Festival

Texas music is fiddle music. The Festival of Texas Fiddling is a celebration of the unique styles and traditions of fiddling across the state. The fiddle has always had a central role in the richness and diversity of Texas music. The Festival is dedicated to preserving and celebrating the range and uniqueness of Texas fiddling, from well-known fiddle styles to cherished regional traditions such as old time, western swing, country, Texas-Mexican fiddling, Gulf Coast and Creole fiddling, and Texas-Polish fiddling. The festival also explores connections between Texas fiddling traditions and those of other states and countries.

Historic Dance Hall

Twin Sisters Hall in Blanco has been the Festival's home since its beginning in 2014, and we will be back again this year. A main goal of the festival is to promote historic Texas halls and their unmatched social and architectural heritage. A benefit of these efforts is increased economic activity in the area as well as the development of new connections with individuals and groups which will endure and continue to grow. No other fiddling events have emphasized the connection between the music and the historic dance halls like the FTF. Uniquely among Texas music events, the Festival preserves the historical and sustainable links between music and the local community.

Audience

The Festival of Texas Fiddling draws an audience from across the state and around the country to Twin Sisters Dance Hall in Blanco. The event has broad and marketable appeal and has grown each year. In 2022, over 800 people attended the daytime festival over two days, with capacity crowds attending the evening dances. Festival attendees have come from across the United States, Europe, Canada and Mexico

Regional and National Partnerships

The Festival of Texas Fiddling produces the event through grants, sponsorships, donations, and partnerships with allied organizations, such as Texas Folklife and the Center for Popular Music. We have received major grant support in multiple years from Humanities Texas for a symposium on Texas fiddle and dance music, and have received additional support from the Lisle Foundation, the Texas State Music Office, and numerous private donors. We have been profiled on Texas Standard, in *Texas Monthly*, and in *Texas Highways*.
